Arts Awards are non-competitive. They don't measure or compare creativity. They **celebrate you, your imagination and your effort** for simply having a go! It's great for beginners who are trying something new and those who are more experienced too.

ARE THERE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

No. Arts Award is for anyone under 25. You choose how to record or share your art. There is no great need for writing, you can use videos, photos or voice recordings. It's accessible for anyone with additional needs or anyone with English as an additional language.

Our Arts Award programme is FREE, thanks to funding from the Community Lottery and Children in Need.

DISCOVER (5+)

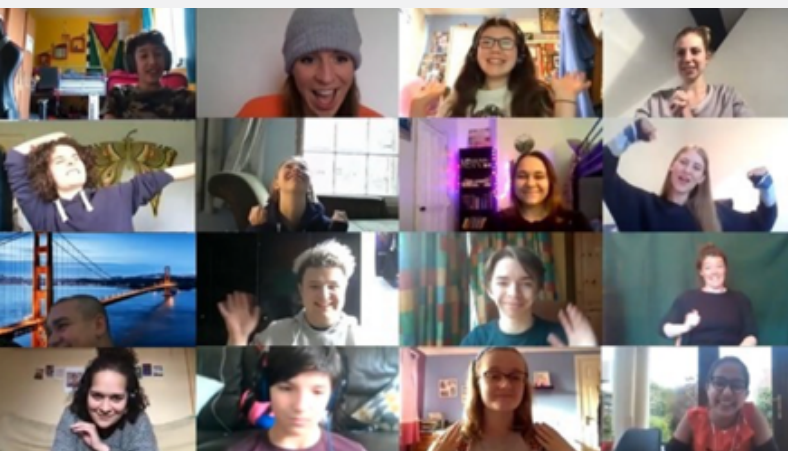
A certificate for all
